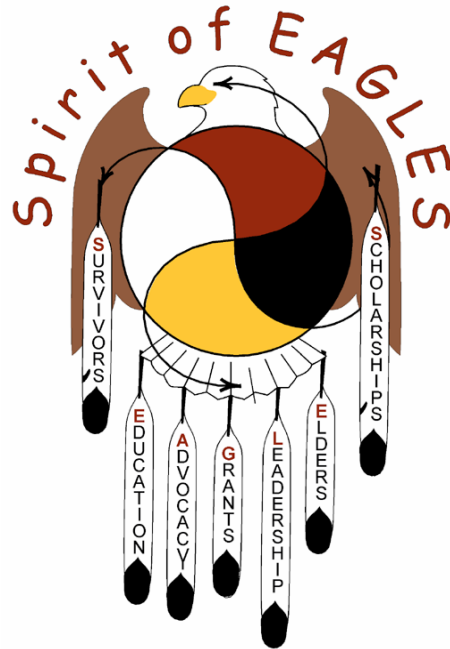

The goal of the September 2007 national conference -- *Changing Cancer Patterns in Native Communities: the Power of Partnerships* -- is to evaluate the progress in prevention of cancer in Native groups through the early diagnosis, treatment, and survival of Native people diagnosed with cancer.
